



General Summary for Thursday, 9 May, 2024



British Mountain Summary: Based on forecast chart for noon 9 May, 2024

Scottish west coast may see some denser clouds and rain patches in the first half of the day, while SW winds weaken gradually. Throughout the day conditions improve, bringing some sunshine to most mountains, perhaps excluding western coastal tops. Fine weather with just some clouds in England and Wales.

How windy? (On the summits)	South to southwesterly 5 to 15mph, strongest on western fells.	South to southeasterly 10 to 20mph.

How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain not expected.	Low risk of showers in the afternoon. Dry most of the day, low risk of showers in the afternoon, highest east of Helvellyn.

Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Mostly sunny with thin high clouds. Good visibility.	Mostly sunny, clouds building up in the afternoon. Slight haze.

Planning Outlook

All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 10 May, 2024

High pressure drifting eastwards during the weekend, whilst southerly breezes brings warmer air and often clear skies, with most places staying dry. A greater risk of some rain or showers by Sunday in the west. Low pressure then moving toward the south of Britain by early next week is likely to strengthen the winds and may bring some rain or showers for a time.
