



Extensive sunshine - beware sunburn - although above the summits, some areas will tend to cloud over in the afternoon. Almost windless and the air very clear indeed. Slight frost many valleys at dawn, but becoming warm in the afternoon,

Planning Outlook**All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 18 May, 2018**

Extensively fine with sunshine and light wind over the coming week to ten days. However, rain will spread inland across western Scotland on Sunday, perhaps reaching eastern mountains before evening. The rain may well continue off and on through Monday, and could also temporarily affect hills near the Irish Sea. The dry conditions should then resume.

On the Scottish Highlands, sustained snowmelt, although some routes, mainly those in from the north onto some Munros are likely to remain blocked by hard snow and ice.
