



## General Summary for Saturday, 15 September, 2018



### British Mountain Summary:

**Based on forecast chart for noon 15 September, 2018**

For most mountain areas something of a lull for a while before gales develop towards or soon after dusk. Cold enough for snow at first in showers over highest tops in Scotland. After initially rising, threat of cloud bases falling over ranges near Irish Sea later in the day.

### Headline for Brecon Beacons

Some sunshine east; strengthening winds evening

## Detailed Forecast for Saturday, 15 September, 2018

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	West backing southwesterly 20 to perhaps 25mph. Will begin to strengthen in the evening.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Fairly small.
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Little or no rain</b> Small rhrreat of one or two drizzly showers west Wales.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Very little</b> Patches on higher tops after dawn are likely to lift above the summits by late morning.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</b>	Sunshine, most widely east Wales, although there may be extensive high level cloud. Very good or excellent visibility.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>	10C.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits.

## Brecon Beacons - Looking Ahead

	<b>Sunday 16 September</b>	<b>Monday 17 September</b>
<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b> <b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Southwesterly typically 40mph at dawn. Will ease gradually to 20 to 25mph by dusk. <b>Walking arduous on higher areas in morning, although conditions will ease.</b>	Southwesterly backing southerly and increasing from 20mph to around 45mph by dusk. <b>Fairly small in morning but increasing amounts of buffeting with likelihood of difficult walking conditions in evening.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain on and off</b> Confidence low: Drizzle on and off and possibly intermittently heavier rain west Wales and perhaps Brecon Beacons. Elsewhere, rain only occasionally - possibly dry easternmost Wales.	<b>Drizzle possible</b> A few patches of drizzle possible. Probably dry later.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>  <b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>Very extensive</b>  Fog across the hills, widely from lower slopes up west Wales and Brecon Beacons. Summits may intermittently or frequently clear east Wales, but improvements very slow elsewhere.  <b>30%</b>	<b>Occasionally extensive</b>  Cloud lowering in any drizzle with patches on some south facing slopes to below 400m for a while. However, possibility of cloud largely dispersing later in the day.  <b>30% rising to 70%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine occasionally east Wales. Hazy.	Glimpses of sunshine at first; then in afternoon a good chance of generally sunny conditions extending from south but turning hazier later in the day.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>  <b>Freezing Level</b>	12C.  Above the summits.	8C rising to 14C  Above summits

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Sunday, 16 September, 2018**

Generally rather cold and unsettled with rain focused onto northwestern ranges. Remains of hurricane Helene threaten to bring very strong winds, a brief appreciable rise of temperatures and locally heavy rain quickly northwards around Monday night and into Tuesday. Showers or longer spells of rain likely across many area at some time on Tuesday and/or Wednesday. Further ahead there appears to be a trend towards higher pressure with a good chance of a significant rise in temperatures for a while. Still a chance of a spell of wet and windy weather in north and west around Friday.
