


# Peak District and Yorkshire Dales

The Peak district and Yorkshire Dales National Parks and the area immediately between them.



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## General Summary for Friday, 10 August, 2018



### British Mountain Summary:

**Based on forecast chart for noon 10 August, 2018**

Widespread showers - generally transferring from western mountains to areas well inland where in afternoon there will be thunderstorms and in places the rain, often heavy becoming constant for an hour or two. Fairly light wind - though temporarily gusty near rain.

### Headline for Peak District and Yorkshire Dales

Heavy showers becoming widespread, hail and thunder. Light wind.

## Detailed Forecast for Friday, 10 August, 2018

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Westerly 15 to occasionally 20mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Small
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Heavy showers and thunderstorms, mainly afternoon.</b> Showers throughout the day, although very few Peak District morning. Some clusters of frequent heavy showers where rain almost constant for an hour or so. Expect hail and risk thunder.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Often above the summits. Nevertheless, quickly forming near rain.</b> Cloud base will vary. Generally, the cloud above the summits. However, near rain, cloud will form quickly, in places from lower slopes up.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	80%
<b>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</b>	Bursts of sunshine between showers. Visibility excellent but deteriorating quickly in heavy rain.
<b>Temperature (at 600m)</b>	11C
<b>And in the valleys</b>	Will reach 16 to 18C in the afternoon, warmest Peak District and eastern dales in Yorkshire. However, expect sudden drop to around 14C in heavy rain.

## Peak District and Yorkshire Dales - Looking Ahead

	<b>Saturday 11 August</b>	<b>Sunday 12 August</b>
<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>  <b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	South or southwesterly 10mph; increasing to 25 to possibly 35mph from afternoon or evening.  <b>Small, before toward evening, walking may well become arduous across higher areas.</b>	Low confidence in this forecast. Southerly; 20-25mph.  <b>Fairly small.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain spreading in late in day</b> During afternoon or more likely evening (timing very uncertain), rain spreading in; highest risk Peak District.	<b>Rain probable</b> Overnight rain will have cleared - and the day may then be substantially dry. However, there is uncertainty as to whether a further band of heavy, perhaps thundery rain will follow.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Very little most or all daylight</b>  Hills cloud free most or all day. However, in rain, fog will begin to shroud the hills.	<b>Likely to form in rain</b>  The summits often free of cloud, although in rain fog is likely to form on higher areas, or from lower slopes up western dales north of Skipton (where it could persist most of the day, even during dry periods).
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>80%</b>	<b>60%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine will slowly give way as high, initially thin, cloud spreads in and progressively thickens. Visibility excellent.	Sunshine intermittently. Frequently excellent visibility, but deteriorating markedly in heavy rain.
<b>Temperature (at 600m)</b>  <b>And in the valleys</b>	11 rising to 14C  Around 20C early afternoon.	16C.  21 to 23C, although nearer 19C western dales in north Yorkshire.

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Saturday, 11 August, 2018**

Colder and wetter countryside over the next week to 10 days. Rain (either as periods of constant rain or just showers) likely at some stage most days, although there will also be dry days. Cloud will often shroud higher tops, particularly western mountains in the mornings.
