

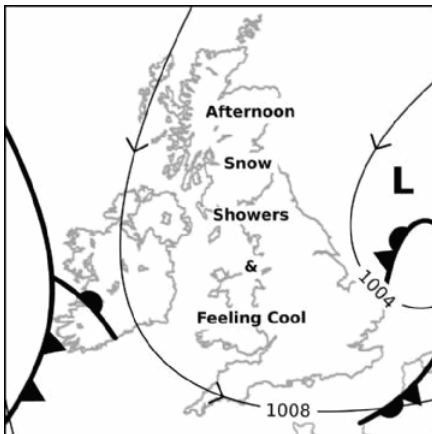
# Brecon Beacons

## General Summary for Thursday, 25 April, 2024



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 25 April, 2024

Cold day across the UK with many areas having northerly winds. Increasing risk of showers in the afternoon in all areas, falling as snow or hail on high ground. Many summits clear, or soon clear of cloud. Fragments of cloud re-forming during showers.

## Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 25 April, 2024

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	West to northwesterly 15 to 25mph, easing from mid-afternoon and into the evening.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Fairly small effect on walking, but continued notable wind chill on hills.
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Showers developing</b> Risk isolated showers near west coast morning, then forming more widely inland afternoon. Snow/hail flurries higher tops.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Mostly above hills</b> Fragments of cloud forming locally around some slopes in the morning, but soon lifting above the tops.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</b>	Variable cloud and sun, best in morning. Visibility good.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>	1C rising to 3 to 5C, warmest Bannau Brycheiniog/Brecon Beacons NP. Wind chill feeling like -4C.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Near freezing sheltered higher areas and valleys at first. Otherwise above freezing to tops.

**Brecon Beacons - Looking Ahead**

	<b>Friday 26 April</b>	<b>Saturday 27 April</b>
<p><b>How windy? (On the summits)</b></p> <p><b>Effect of wind on you?</b></p>	<p>Light winds, 5 to perhaps 15mph. Variable direction but tending to be easterly or southeasterly.</p> <p><b>Negligible or small.</b></p>	<p>Some uncertainly. Probably easterly 15 to 25mph.</p> <p><b>Walking just beginning to be impacted and may feel uncomfortable for some. Marked wind chill in the morning.</b></p>
<p><b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)</p>	<p><b>Mostly dry</b></p> <p>Risk of occasional drizzle or light shower, particularly Cambrian Mountains.</p>	<p><b>Risk of light showers.</b></p> <p>Mostly dry through the day. Risk of light showers in the afternoon. Then heavy rain overnight, may begin in the evening.</p>
<p><b>Cloud on the hills?</b></p> <p><b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b></p>	<p><b>Lifting above most tops</b></p> <p>Any morning hill fog will lift and clear summits. Patches of cloud re-forming on higher slopes, especially during and after showers. Bases rising in the afternoon.</p> <p><b>70%</b></p>	<p>Many summit shrouded at first, slowly lifting and breaking through the day. Some patches may reform during and after showers. Cloud becoming widespread in the evening and extensive overnight.</p> <p><b>50%</b></p>
<p><b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)</p>	<p>Widespread sunshine in morning become patchy as clouds form in the afternoon. Good visibility; hazy near south coast.</p>	<p>Patchy sunshine at times, but may often feel overcast. Good visibility.</p>
<p><b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b></p> <p><b>Freezing Level</b></p>	<p>2C rising towards 5C. Feeling as cold as -5C in the wind at times.</p> <p>Above the summits.</p>	<p>1C in the morning, when it may as cold as -10C in the wind. Rising to 5C in the afternoon.</p> <p>Above the summits.</p>

**Planning Outlook**

**All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 26 April, 2024**

Remaining cold, especially northern England and Scotland. Initially winds remaining light but showers increasingly likely, falling as snow or hail on high ground. Small but active low bringing wind and precipitation to England and Wales on Sunday. Remaining showery and on-and-off cold into the early part of next week.
