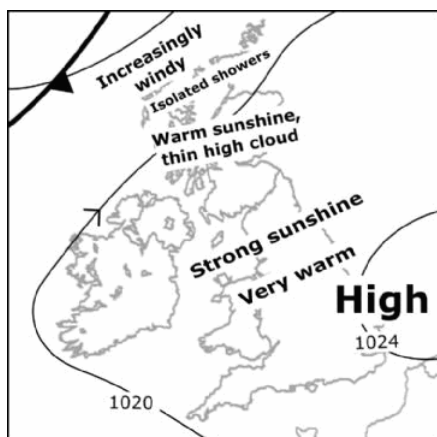

#### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 30 April, 2025

Fine and warm, or very warm Wales and Pennines. Strong sunshine, some thin high cloud; beware sunburn and dehydration. Toward northwest Scotland, strengthening southwesterly winds, more cloud at times, one or two brief showers. Into night, some rain moves into Scotland from the west.

Sunny and very warm, light winds.

### Detailed Forecast for Wednesday, 30 April, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Variable or southeasterly, 15mph or less.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Negligible
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	None expected
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	100%
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Bright sunshine. Visibility very good, but may start hazy.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>	12C rising to 17C. Some valleys especially in east and mid-Wales rising to 25C afternoon.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits
