

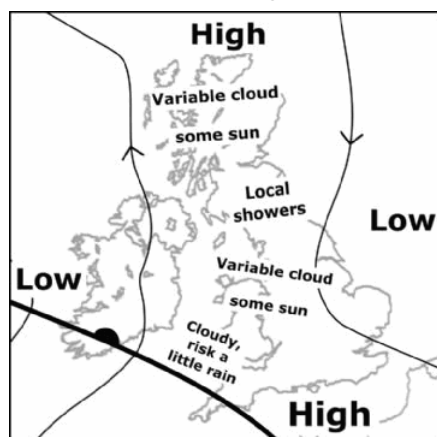
# Cairngorms NP and Monadhliath

## General Summary for Wednesday, 16 July, 2025



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 16 July, 2025

Fine much of the day for many areas, cloud covering some hill slopes in the morning, tending to lift above many summits. A little patchy rain mostly southern Scotland and northern England in the morning, tending to fade. Isolated showers into afternoon. Mostly light winds.

### Headline for Cairngorms NP and Monadhliath

Largely dry, chance a shower; cloud patches clear. Light wind.

## Detailed Forecast for Wednesday, 16 July, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the Munros)</b>	Easterly 10-15mph some slopes in morning. Otherwise variable direction 10mph or less.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Negligible</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain unlikely</b> Small risk of an isolated shower.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Mostly little, some early cloud north</b> Local pockets of mist or cloud just above some glens from dawn. Fragments of cloud briefly form around some slopes, local cloud banks drifting onto north Cairngorms for a few hours, but soon likely to lift or disperse.
<b>Chance of cloud free Munros?</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Patchwork of cloud and sun, some mist possible in morning, otherwise visibility excellent.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	10C rising to 13 to 15C.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits
