

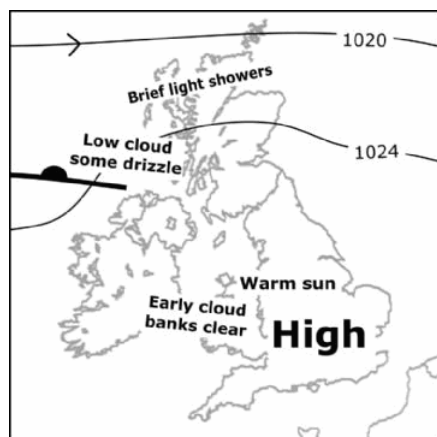

## General Summary for Wednesday, 18 June, 2025



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 18 June, 2025

West to southwest breezes will feel cool over Scottish mountains, strongest toward the north. Cloud will be drawn onto western hills, some drizzly rain or brief showers. Higher cloud eastwards, often above tops. England & Wales dry and mostly sunny, warmest south.

### Headline for Lake District

Fine with sun, fells largely clear, light-moderate breezes.

## Detailed Forecast for Wednesday, 18 June, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Westerly 15 to 20mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Fairly small
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain not expected
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Little or none</b> Patches on some upper slopes mostly western areas in the morning. Lifting above most or all tops.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine and broken cloud. Visibility very good.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>	8C rising to 11C.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits

## All mountain areas of Britain from Thursday, 19 June, 2025

High pressure centred to the east draws very warm air in on southerly breezes through the rest of this week. Dry conditions, sunshine and fair-weather cloud, some patchy coastal cloud at times in west, locally gustier winds too. A more uncertain outlook into the weekend and early next week, a good deal of fine and warm weather possible, but risk of some rain or showery bursts at times.
