

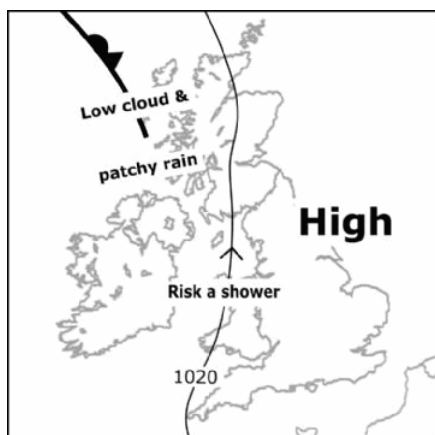
# Lake District

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## General Summary for Saturday, 23 August, 2025



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 23 August, 2025

Cloudy skies for many places, varied areas of low cloud on some hill slopes in the morning, largely lifting above the tops, but may continue to cap higher western mountains in Scotland, with a little rain occasionally. An odd shower in north Wales in afternoon. Winds generally light.

### Headline for Lake District

Largely dry, cloud mostly above hills; light winds.

## Detailed Forecast for Saturday, 23 August, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Variable west becoming southerly, 5 to 10mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Negligible
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain unlikely</b> Chance an odd patch of drizzle around early low cloud. Small risk an isolated light shower afternoon.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Mostly little or clearing</b> Patchy cloud may drift across some slopes in the morning. Most or all cloud likely soon above the hills.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>Soon 90%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Occasional sun and mostly thin high cloud. May start misty, visibility becoming excellent.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>	9C from dawn. Rising to 14C afternoon.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits

**All mountain areas of Britain from Sunday, 24 August, 2025**

High pressure drifts slowly east, whilst low pressure over the Atlantic encroaches nearer in the early part of the new week. Southeasterly winds increasing Sunday-Monday, soonest for western regions, becoming much windier by Monday in west, then more widely with time. Areas of rain and showery bursts increasingly widespread as the week progresses as low pressure then rotates slowly over Britain - day-to-day detail becomes very uncertain. Warmer and more humid for a time, then cooler later in week.

Forecasts are issued daily by 16:30 and are kept under review and amended as necessary. However, expected conditions can still change after issue. © Copyright Mountain Weather Information Service, 2025.
