

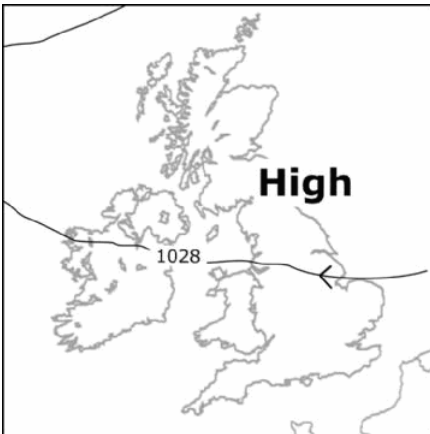

General Summary for Sunday, 21 June, 2026



**British Mountain Summary:
Based on forecast chart for noon 21 June, 2026**

Extensive bright sunshine - beware of sunburn and dehydration - and light wind. Cloud and a few brief showers NW Highlands will move away north, whilst along the Pennines and later Cumbria and S Scotland, patchy cloud and an isolated shower will form.

Headline for Lake District

Light wind; bright sunshine and very clear air.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 21 June, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Easterly or variable, 10mph or less, but may reach 20mph for a few hours.
Effect of wind on you?	Mostly negligible.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain very unlikely Very remote risk isolated brief burst of rain later toward evening.
Cloud on the hills?	Not expected
Chance of cloud free summits?	Above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Bright sunshine morning, weakening at times afternoon. Visibility excellent or superb.
How Cold? (at 750m)	10C at dawn, rising to 17C afternoon.
Freezing Level	Above the summits.

	Monday 22 June	Tuesday 23 June
How windy? (On the summits)	Southterly between 15 and perhaps 25mph.	Southwesterly 15 to perhaps 25mph,.
Effect of wind on you?	Fairly small	Fairly small.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Risk bursts of rain, possibly thundery Confidence low: probably dry. But small risk of a few bursts of rain, perhaps brief although possibly isolated thunder.	Rain very unlikely
Cloud on the hills?	Very little for most of the day - may form in rain. Generally the hills free of cloud although fog may form on higher slopes in rain.	Little if any Fog here and there after dawn - clearing within a few hours
Chance of cloud free summits?	90%	Soon almost certain
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Patches of sunshine although extensive high level cloud. Visibility good, although a haze.	Sunshine extensive, sometimes weak due to thin high level cloud. Very good visibility although hazy.
How Cold? (at 750m)	17C - very warm and also humid.	17C rising to a very warm (and exceptionally humid) 21C.
Freezing Level	Above the summits	Above the summits.

Planning Outlook**All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 22 June, 2026**

Extensively dry, very warm but very humid indeed England and Wales, although around Monday chance of a thunderstorm. Rain and low cloud at times Scotland, mainly affecting western mountains - although later next week the warmth encroaching into Scotland. There may well be widespread thunderstorms later in the week, before less hot weather extends from the Atlantic around next weekend.
