

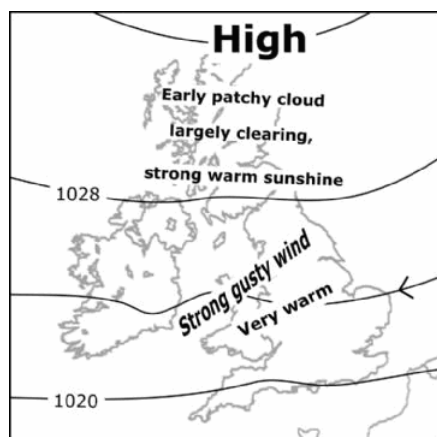
Lake District

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General Summary for Monday, 13 July, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 13 July, 2026

Varied banks of cloud around hills in Scotland and Pennines early in the day, but increasingly dispersing during the morning to leave most or all hills clear. Strong sunshine, pleasant temperatures, warmest in western areas. Mostly light wind for the Highlands, gusty easterly further south. Very warm for Wales.

Headline for Lake District

Warm sunshine, fells clear, gusty breeze.

Detailed Forecast for Monday, 13 July, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Easterly 10-15mph, frequent gusts over tops and elevated passes, pushing downslope early and late 20-25mph.
Effect of wind on you?	Fairly small, but nuisance gusts common over high terrain most of the day.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain expected
Cloud on the hills?	Likely none Briefly a few ribbons of cloud on eastern fells below the summits, these soon lifting and dissipating in the early morning for clear fells.
Chance of cloud free summits?	Above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Extensive sunshine. Very good visibility. High UV, beware sunburn.
How Cold? (at 750m)	13C rising to 17 or 18C, warmest western fells, (up to 25C in valleys afternoon).
Freezing Level	Above the summits.

Lake District - Looking Ahead

	Tuesday 14 July	Wednesday 15 July
How windy? (On the summits) Effect of wind on you?	Easterly 15 to 25mph, local gusts 30mph around some upper slopes, strongest speeds not necessarily on summits. Breezy over the fells, in places gustiness may start to affect comfortable walking, feeling cooler where exposed.	Easterly 15 to 20mph, some gusty spots 25mph, not just on the highest terrain, local 30mph possible western Lakeland. Fairly small, but feeling breezier in places around higher fells, some more notable gusts toward the west in morning.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain expected	No rain expected
Cloud on the hills?	Mostly clear, early patches Patchy fog at first in some valleys and brief fragments drift over tops mainly north and east Lakes, but all dispersing for clear fells, many areas clear all day.	Fells clear Patchy mist some valleys and brief fragments around some northeast slopes at first, but soon all dispersing.
Chance of cloud free summits?	Above 90%	Practically certain
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Mostly sunny. Visibility very good.	Strong sunshine all day. Excellent visibility on high terrain, some low-level haze.
How Cold? (at 750m) Freezing Level	13C from dawn, rising to 18C (valleys reach 25C). Above the summits.	14C or warmer on high tops (warmer than valleys), rising to 18C afternoon (valleys reach 25C). Above the summits.

Planning Outlook**All mountain areas of Britain from Tuesday, 14 July, 2026**

A fine week of summer weather - warm and dry with pleasantly warm temperatures and often plenty of sunshine. High pressure keeps the skies mostly clear, some low-level cloud rolling inland from the North Sea at times. A prevailing easterly flow, pushing the warmest temperatures for western hill groups, valley temperatures often 25C, or warmer for Wales and Peak District, at times 30C. A fairly sustained breeze most of the week in England and Wales, at times stronger and quite gusty. Notably dry ground conditions, beware very high fire risk. A cooling trend toward the weekend as north-northeasterly winds develop, a few showers possible, but a dry theme likely into early next week.
