

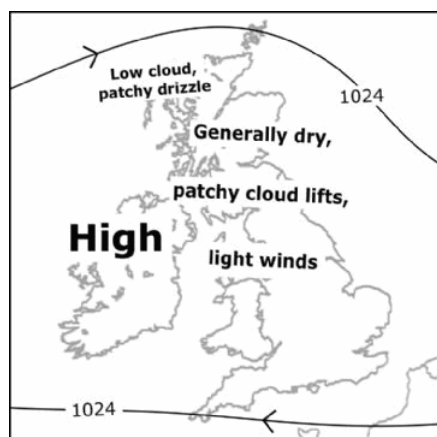
Lake District

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General Summary for Sunday, 23 August, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 23 August, 2026

A fine day for most places with light winds. Patchy cloud around some hill slopes early in the day will lift to leave many summits clear, but cloud banks are likely to persist on west coastal tops in Scotland, a little drizzle here in the morning, breezier too in the far northwest.

Headline for Lake District

Patchy cloud lifts above tops; generally dry.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 23 August, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Northwesterly 10mph at first, becoming variable often little wind.
Effect of wind on you?	Negligible.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Little or none Small chance spots of drizzly rain around early cloud, but dry overall.
Cloud on the hills?	Lifting off the summits Local cloud patches, mostly north & western fells early in day, lifting to high tops then above all fells by middle of day. Some patchy mist in valleys at first soon dispersing.
Chance of cloud free summits?	Rising above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Patchwork of cloud and sun, becoming sunnier near the coasts in afternoon. Very good visibility.
How Cold? (at 750m)	9C rising to 13C.
Freezing Level	Above the summits.

All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 24 August, 2026

A fine start to the week with high pressure nearby, but easterly breezes will tend to strengthen. Most places dry through Monday and Tuesday, but generally deteriorating from the south into midweek as low pressure moves in from the south, patchy rain will increasingly spread northward with some local stronger wind. Broadly unsettled as next weekend approaches with bands of heavy rain forming mixed with showery bursts at times, but fairly warm and somewhat humid. Wind speed and direction likely to vary considerably day-to-day.
