


# Peak District

## General Summary for Thursday, 25 November, 2021



### British Mountain Summary:

**Based on forecast chart for noon 25 November, 2021**

A cold, windy but fine day on summits along most of the spine of Britain and also South Wales. However, snow showers will affect the NW Highlands and increasingly from the west other summits in W Scotland, and west Wales will later become prone to showers.

### Headline for Peak District

Cold. Windy, particularly at first. Dry; bright sun.

## Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 25 November, 2021

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	North or northwesterly; 30-35mph after dawn, but gradually easing to 25mph, perhaps 20mph by mid afternoon.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Walking arduous where exposed on higher areas, mainly morning.</b>
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Precipitation not expected</b>
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Very little if any</b> Summits extensively cloud free.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>Almost certain</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Bright sunshine particularly morning. The air very clear.
<b>Temperature (at 600m)</b>	0C
<b>And in the valleys</b>	Close to or just above freezing point in a few valleys at dawn. Will rise to 6 or 7C early afternoon.

## Peak District - Looking Ahead

	Friday 26 November	Saturday 27 November
<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b> <b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	West or northwesterly in the range 35 to perhaps later 50mph. Sudden strong gusts, particularly near precipitation. <b>Significant wind chill and difficult walking conditions, including sudden gusts - these reaching lower slopes.</b>	Northerly 40 to 50mph; tending to drop marginally through day. <b>Upland gales will result in significant wind chill and frequent considerable buffeting on higher areas; at times general mobility difficult.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Showers, increasingly of snow</b> A mix of showery periods, and most likely morning an hour or so when precipitation almost constant - progressively turning to snow, later above 500m. Hail and risk thunder in morning.	<b>Snow showers</b> Snow showers or flurries from time to time.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Hills intermittently cloud free</b>  Will vary, sometimes quickly. Cloud extensively above 500m but nearer 300m more western slopes at first, but by midday will extensively clear.	<b>Summits often cloud free</b>  Occasionally cloud below 500m but often cloud base near or above higher tops.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>50%</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Glimpses of sun. Visibility changing quickly, sometimes good, but abruptly very poor in snow.	Patches of sunshine. Visibility very good.
<b>Temperature (at 600m)</b>  <b>And in the valleys</b>	3C dropping to 1C  Will vary between 6 and occasionally 8C through the day - sudden drop in temperature near showers.	-2C  Will reach 4 to locally 6C at best early afternoon.

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 26 November, 2021**

On Friday and Saturday, the Scottish Highlands will bear the brunt of cold, stormy conditions with considerable snowfall (especially Cairngorms NP).

There may well be a lull on Sunday as winds drop and most areas are temporarily dry (possibly snow edging onto some western mountains). Next week, precipitation frequent, with further bouts of upland gales or severe gales. Temperature levels will vary: a series of freeze thaw cycles Scottish Highlands, whilst elsewhere higher tops only occasionally below freezing point.
