

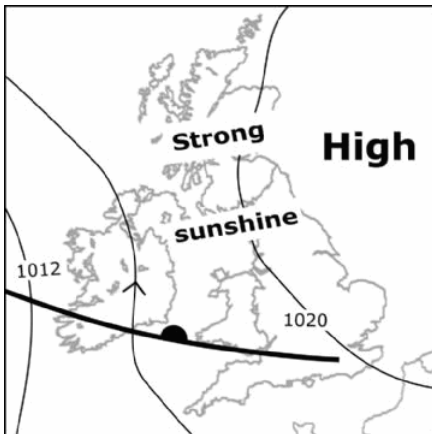
Peak District

General Summary for Sunday, 11 August, 2024



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 11 August, 2024

A fine, warm and sunny day for most places. Early light showers in northwest Scotland fading. Increasingly humid Wales and south Pennines. Light winds in the morning, strengthening southeasterlies in afternoon; toward dusk reaching gale-force near west coast of Scotland - bursts of rain arriving here into the night.

Headline for Peak District

Breeze increasing, but becoming humid. Strong sunshine.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 11 August, 2024

How windy? (On the summits)	Southeasterly, speeds rising during daytime from 10 to 20mph. Reaching gusty 25-35mph into the night.
Effect of wind on you?	Small, becoming noticeably breezier during afternoon; more blustery into the night.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain expected
Cloud on the hills?	Hills clear
Chance of cloud free summits?	Almost certain
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunny day, high UV; thin high cloud. Very good visibility, slight haze.
Temperature (at 600m)	15C rising to 19C afternoon, increasingly humid; slightly warmer by evening, but offset by the strengthening winds.
And in the valleys	14C at dawn. Rising to a warm 25C by afternoon, staying muggy into evening.

<p>How windy? (On the summits)</p> <p>Effect of wind on you?</p>	<p>Southerly, gusty 30mph from before dawn into morning. Then southwesterly, 15 to 20mph or less. Very blustery conditions early in day, but likely to moderate with time to become fairly small.</p>	<p>South to southwesterly, 20 to 25mph. Breezy over higher moors, may start to affect comfortable walking where exposed.</p>
<p>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</p>	<p>Chance thundery rain for a time Possible bursts of rain, locally thundery, tracking northeastwards in the morning. Likely to clear to leave rare brief showers.</p>	<p>Risk of rain developing later Dry morning, and well into afternoon much of the region, then patchy drizzly rain developing from the west, risk becoming more persistent rain later in daytime.</p>
<p>Cloud on the hills?</p> <p>Chance of cloud free summits?</p>	<p>Mostly clearing Banks of cloud over higher slopes for a time, mainly during morning or if rain occurs locally, but likely to lift and disperse to leave hills often clear.</p> <p>70%</p>	<p>Mostly little Local cloud banks in the morning on some slopes, but breaking up to be mostly above the hills through middle of day. Later if rain develops, cloud lowering from west, filling in to be extensive over hills later.</p> <p>70%</p>
<p>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</p>	<p>Some sun developing as high cloud thins. Visibility mostly good, reduced if rain occurs locally.</p>	<p>Variable cloud cover and a little sun. Visibility mostly very good, reducing if rain develops later.</p>
<p>Temperature (at 600m)</p> <p>And in the valleys</p>	<p>Humid 17C from before dawn into morning, but likely to fall during day as a cold front passes, to around 13C. A muggy 21 to 24C despite risk of rain at times, possibly 27C if sun breaks through; starting to feel fresher later in day.</p>	<p>12 to 15C. 12C at dawn, rising to 19 to 21C.</p>

Planning Outlook

All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 12 August, 2024

West to southwesterly winds will prevail during the week ahead, maintaining generally unsettled weather patterns coming in from the Atlantic. Frequent and at times heavy rainfall concentrated over western mountains, where ground conditions increasingly saturated. Often extensive low cloud. Periods of strong to gale-force winds are likely midweek onward. Generally cool and unsettled toward next weekend.
