

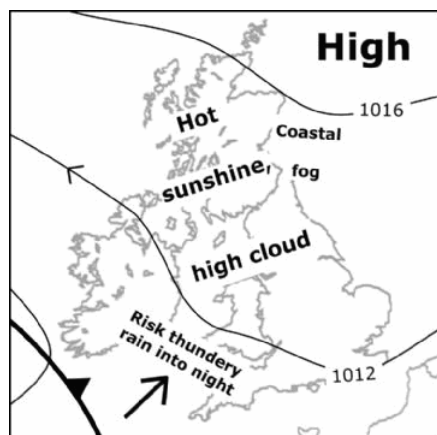
Peak District

General Summary for Sunday, 13 July, 2025



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 13 July, 2025

Very warm across the mountains from overnight, soon feeling hot in morning sun. Some valleys again approaching 30C by early afternoon, though mostly slightly less hot than Saturday. A veil of high cloud tending to weaken the sun. Local gusty E-SE'ly winds. Generally dry, later a chance of very isolated showers.

Headline for Peak District

Very warm, sun and increasing high cloud, gusty in places.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 13 July, 2025

How windy? (On the summits)	Easterly 15-20mph. Breezier in the morning, local gusts 25mph downslope in the west.
Effect of wind on you?	Mostly small, some occasional gusty spots may feel noticeable.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain very unlikely during daytime Chance local spots of rain from high cloud later in the day. Remote risk an isolated burst of rain forming into the evening.
Cloud on the hills?	Hills clear
Chance of cloud free summits?	100%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunny at dawn, then patchy high cloud building, increasingly shrouding sun. Excellent visibility.
Temperature (at 600m)	16C rising to 20C.
And in the valleys	13C at dawn, rising to 27C, locally warmer southernmost areas.

All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 14 July, 2025

Low pressure is likely to be common in the extended outlook with slow-moving areas of showery rain, some thundery bursts locally, interspersed with drier days. Temperatures often on the warm side, some humid days.

Forecast issued at 16:00 on Saturday, 12 July, 2025
