

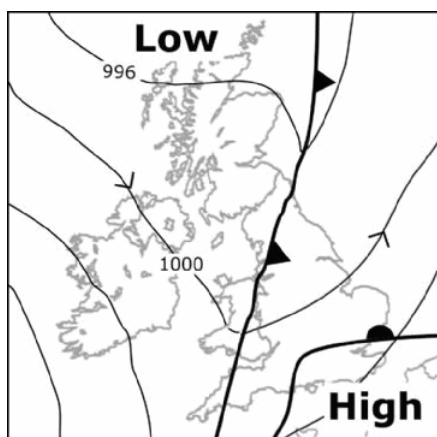
# Peak District

## General Summary for Tuesday, 13 January, 2026



### British Mountain Summary:

**Based on forecast chart for noon 13 January, 2026**

A cold front will move southeastwards bringing a few hours of precipitation - although still some uncertainty in its exact shape and position. Snow and hail showers will affect W Scotland whilst most other areas will have a few hours of rain, in places finishing as snow, as the temperature drops.

### Headline for Peak District

Rain for a few hours. Intermittently windy.

## Detailed Forecast for Tuesday, 13 January, 2026

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Changing through day: In morning southerly 40mph, then a lull before westerly 30mph later afternoon.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Walking on higher areas intermittently arduous and wind chill considerable.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain for a few hours</b> Two to four hours of rain middle of day and afternoon.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Blanket of low cloud probable</b> Cloud may well fill in or have filled in across the hills, and persist all day.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>20%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine not expected. Widely misty or murky in rain.
<b>Temperature (at 600m)</b>	6C. Will feel as cold as minus 4C where exposed to the wind.
<b>And in the valleys</b>	Between 7 and 9C

**All mountain areas of Britain from Wednesday, 14 January, 2026**

Temperature wise, it is highly likely to remain colder than recent January's with the snow pack across the Scottish Highlands being enhanced by further snowfall, whilst further south snow accumulates on higher areas, and occasional falls reaching lower slopes.
