

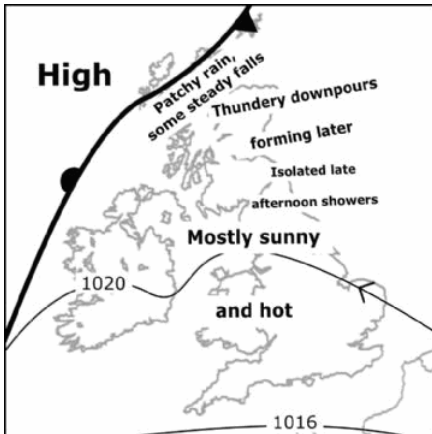
Peak District

General Summary for Friday, 10 July, 2026



British Mountain Summary: Based on forecast chart for noon 10 July, 2026

Hot sunshine persists across England, Wales, and southern Scotland; valley temperatures of 30C+. Starting bright and becoming very warm most of Scottish Highlands. Rain from Lochaber northward, later moving east with heavy thundery bursts forming over central/east highlands into evening.

Hot sunshine, some afternoon fair weather cloud

Detailed Forecast for Friday, 10 July, 2026

<p>How windy? (On the summits)</p> <p>Effect of wind on you?</p>	<p>Southeasterly 10 to 15mph in the morning, notable gusts approaching 20mph over tops early in the day. An easing trend, later shifting easterly, some gusts reforming over tops and downslope into evening.</p> <p>Small.</p>
<p>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</p>	<p>Any rain unlikely</p> <p>Late in the day, small chance of a very isolated burst of rain, most likely dry.</p>
<p>Cloud on the hills?</p> <p>Chance of cloud free summits?</p>	<p>Hills clear</p> <p>Practically certain</p>
<p>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</p>	<p>Strong sunshine, some thin high cloud, fair weather cloud building afternoon.</p> <p>A haze affecting visibility.</p>
<p>Temperature (at 600m)</p> <p>And in the valleys</p>	<p>19C at dawn rising to 26 or 27C; not as humid as other hills groups.</p> <p>16C at dawn, rising toward 31C afternoon.</p>

How windy? (On the summits) Effect of wind on you?	Easterly 10-15mph, strengthening trend late in the day approaching 20-25mph after dark. Small.	Easterly 15-25mph. Strongest wind early, sustained speeds near the high end of the range, gusting 35mph too. Ease of walking at times affected on high terrain, particularly early hours when strongest gusts affect stability.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Likely dry Small chance of an odd spot of rain popping up in the late afternoon or evening.	No rain expected
Cloud on the hills? Chance of cloud free summits?	Hills clear Nearly certain	Extensive early, clearing A veil of cloud covers the moors from overnight, extensive over all high terrain, to middle or lower eastern slopes. Soon after sunrise, cloud begins to lift and break, likely none left on the moors by late morning. 20% rising to 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Extensive sunshine, some thin high cloud at times. Excellent visibility.	Overcast and foggy at dawn, cloud gradually breaking for extensive afternoon sun with good visibility; some thin high cloud.
Temperature (at 600m) And in the valleys	15C rising to 23C. 15C at dawn, rising to 27C.	13C rising to 20C. 14C at dawn rising to 24 to 26C, western valleys noticeably warmer.

Planning Outlook**All mountain areas of Britain from Saturday, 11 July, 2026**

Staying warm in Scotland, hot for England and Wales into the weekend. High pressure shifts northward, facilitating a strengthening easterly wind across most areas. Some lingering cloud and rain over the Scottish Highlands Saturday with some risk of heavier thundery bursts on Saturday morning in the east. The weekend is likely dry across England and Wales with fairly extensive sun, some sea fog increasingly affecting northeastern hill groups later weekend.

Easterly wind persists next week, sometimes quite strong England and Wales. Mostly sunny and very warm, including Scottish Highlands. Low pressure south of the country starts pushing showers into Wales, some heavy and thundery, though confidence is low. Detail increasing uncertain later next week, but Scotland likely stays dry.
