

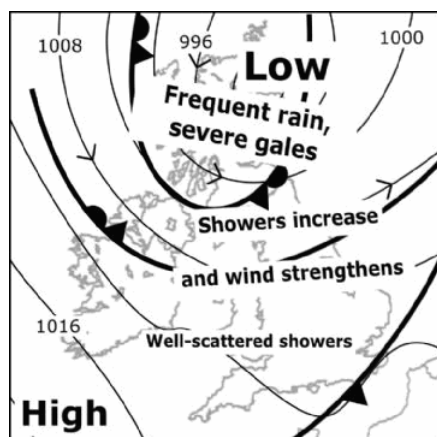
Peak District

General Summary for Tuesday, 8 September, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 8 September, 2026

Frequent rain and severe gales over Scottish Highlands, easing from west later; feeling cold. Strong wind with showers and sun breaks in south Scotland and England, showers increasingly frequent from north, extended falls forming. Showers scattered in Wales, least rain south with lighter wind.

Headline for Peak District

Becoming very windy; scattered showers increasingly frequent

Detailed Forecast for Tuesday, 8 September, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	West-southwesterly 30-40mph. Later in the day, shifting westerly and later northwesterly, trending towards the higher end of the range, gusts approaching 45mph.
Effect of wind on you?	Strenuous walking with notable wind chill all day, strongest gusts in exposure late in the day will begin to challenge stability.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Scattered showers, increasing Scattered showers drift onto the hills from the west, gradually increasing in frequency, some extended falls forming later but generally remaining showery.
Cloud on the hills?	Largely clear tops well into the day Varied cloud above middle slopes in the early morning will lift to clear the summits well into the day. As showers become more frequent, patches start to lower onto the summits in and after rain.
Chance of cloud free summits?	80%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine in and out through fast-moving patchy cloud. Visibility generally good but a haze, particularly western areas.
Temperature (at 600m)	7 or 8C rising up to 10C, though will vary around showers. Feeling around freezing in strongest direct wind.
And in the valleys	9C at dawn, rising to 14 or 15C, though will vary a few degrees around showers, and trending cooler before nightfall.

All mountain areas of Britain from Wednesday, 9 September, 2026

Weather remains varied from the weekend into next week, Scotland most often unsettled, best windows of improvement to the south. A more settled period is indicated in the later month with warm temperatures.
