

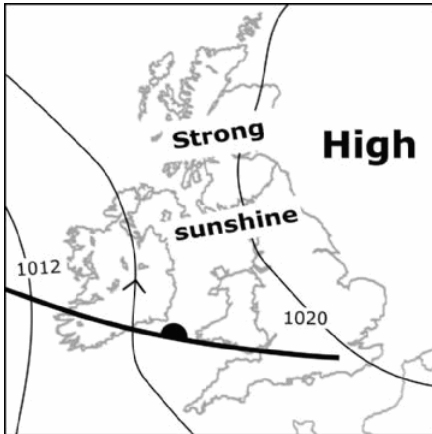

General Summary for Sunday, 11 August, 2024



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 11 August, 2024

A fine, warm and sunny day for most places. Early light showers in northwest Scotland fading. Increasingly humid Wales and south Pennines. Light winds in the morning, strengthening southeasterlies in afternoon; toward dusk reaching gale-force near west coast of Scotland - bursts of rain arriving here into the night.

Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Increasingly breezy but humid. Sun and high cloud.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 11 August, 2024

How windy? (On the summits)	Southeasterly, 15mph in the morning, strengthening, to 25mph afternoon, reaching gusty 35mph by evening and over 40mph at times onward into night.
Effect of wind on you?	Starting small, becoming blustery toward the evening and strengthening gusts may affect balance on exposed ridges.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain very unlikely Small risk spots of rain locally forming if high cloud thickens.
Cloud on the hills?	Hills generally clear Morning mist in some valleys and briefly on some hill slopes, but soon all dispersing to leave cloud above the hills.
Chance of cloud free summits?	Above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunny most of the day, high cloud building into afternoon. Excellent visibility, becoming hazier.
How Cold? (at 900m)	14C rising to 17C afternoon, increasingly humid; slightly warmer by evening, but offset by the strengthening winds.
Freezing Level	Above the summits

<p>How windy? (On the summits)</p> <p>Effect of wind on you?</p>	<p>Very gusty 40mph up to dawn, but likely soon easing. Most of day, west to southwesterly 10 to 20mph.</p> <p>Soon small</p>	<p>South to southwesterly, 20 to 35mph.</p> <p>Blustery over higher terrain, affecting balance and comfortable walking on exposed tops and ridges.</p>
<p>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</p>	<p>Often dry</p> <p>Any residual overnight bursts of rain soon clearing from dawn. Then occasional showers, mostly light.</p>	<p>Rain and drizzle</p> <p>Drizzly rain soon pushing in from the west to be fairly persistent, steadier rain setting in increasingly widely. Smaller amounts toward east and northeast Wales.</p>
<p>Cloud on the hills?</p> <p>Chance of cloud free summits?</p>	<p>Cloud banks lifting and breaking</p> <p>Banks of cloud from some lower slopes upward at first, may persist near to coast, but tending to lift and thin, greater breaks forming with time.</p> <p>50%</p>	<p>Extensive, very low cloud west</p> <p>Cloud shrouding most hills all day above 400 to 600m, but filling in from lower slopes upward near to Irish Sea. Highest cloud bases toward northeast of A5, but any early breaks likely short-lived.</p> <p>10%</p>
<p>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</p>	<p>Some sun developing as high cloud thins.</p> <p>Misty start, visibility improving to become good.</p>	<p>Mostly overcast and dull; poor visibility most of day in west.</p> <p>Any early brightness giving way; possible good visibility in morning inland/east.</p>
<p>How Cold? (at 900m)</p> <p>Freezing Level</p>	<p>Humid 15C from before dawn into morning, falling as a cold front passes, then 10 to 12C.</p> <p>Above the summits</p>	<p>10 to 12C.</p> <p>Above the summits</p>

Planning Outlook

All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 12 August, 2024

West to southwesterly winds will prevail during the week ahead, maintaining generally unsettled weather patterns coming in from the Atlantic. Frequent and at times heavy rainfall concentrated over western mountains, where ground conditions increasingly saturated. Often extensive low cloud. Periods of strong to gale-force winds are likely midweek onward. Generally cool and unsettled toward next weekend.
