

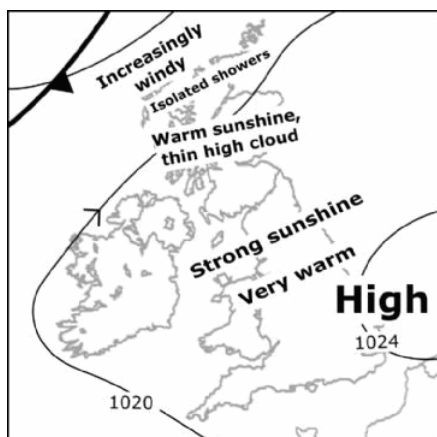

General Summary for Wednesday, 30 April, 2025



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 30 April, 2025

Fine and warm, or very warm Wales and Pennines. Strong sunshine, some thin high cloud; beware sunburn and dehydration. Toward northwest Scotland, strengthening southwesterly winds, more cloud at times, one or two brief showers. Into night, some rain moves into Scotland from the west.

Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Sunny and very warm, light winds.

Detailed Forecast for Wednesday, 30 April, 2025

How windy? (On the summits)	Variable or southerly, 15mph or less.
Effect of wind on you?	Negligible
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain
Cloud on the hills?	None expected
Chance of cloud free summits?	100%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Bright sunshine, early thin high cloud clearing. Visibility very good, but may start hazy.
How Cold? (at 900m)	12C rising to 14C, local 16C northern areas afternoon. Some valleys inland and toward north of high ground reaching 25C afternoon.
Freezing Level	Above the summits
