

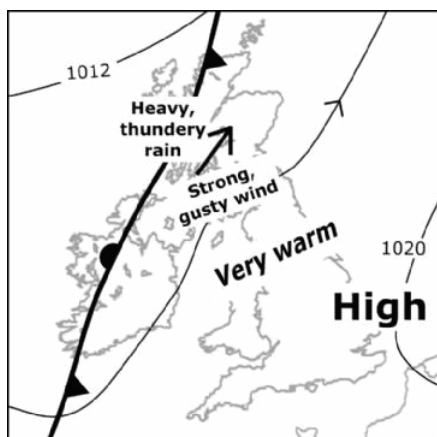
# Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

## General Summary for Monday, 30 June, 2025



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 30 June, 2025

Very warm and humid. Gale force southerly winds for NW Scotland at first will ease, but gusty winds strengthen elsewhere. As a front encroaches from the west across the Highlands, bursts of rain will merge into a swathe of more extensive heavy rain, possible thunder. Dry with sunshine for England and Wales, small risk local showers.

### Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Increasingly breezy. Very warm; sunny, some coastal mist.

## Detailed Forecast for Monday, 30 June, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Southerly 20 to 30mph, strongest Snowdon/Yr Wyddfa range, gusty in places; later afternoon southwesterly 35mph for a time.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Affecting comfortable walking and balance on some exposed ridges, becoming strenuous for periods higher terrain.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Very likely dry</b> Some fine drizzle possible near coast if in cloud early morning. Most likely all day dry, but later afternoon, small chance of a very isolated burst of rain forming, mainly over mid to north-east Wales.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Little or none away from coastal slopes</b> Most mountains clear apart from occasional early patches in west. Very low cloud / fog near to the coast particularly morning, tending to thin and break up, but patches may linger.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine and some thin high cloud. Visibility very good, but some early haze or mist, which may linger near Llyn peninsula.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	15C where in cloud, up to 19C inland areas; very humid. Starting to drop into the night.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits

## Eryri / Snowdonia National Park - Looking Ahead

	<b>Tuesday 1 July</b>	<b>Wednesday 2 July</b>
<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	West or southwesterly 10 to 15mph or less.	Northerly or variable 15 to 20mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Small</b>	<b>Fairly small</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Risk bursts of rain</b> Occasional rain, local showery bursts, mostly well inland later in the day, chance isolated thunder.	<b>Possible patchy rain or showers</b> Risk occasional rain, may be just spots from high cloud. Scattered showers mostly inland and east, mainly afternoon.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Fairly extensive, some very low cloud</b>  Covering the hills fairly widely in the morning, lowest toward coasts, possible fog to mid-slopes or lower for a time. Tending to lift and break gradually, but cloud banks may linger all day.	<b>Covering tops for a time</b>  Banks of cloud drifting over higher slopes, particularly northern areas in the morning. Lifting to tops and may largely clear above the summits.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>40%</b>	<b>60%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Fairly cloudy, glimpses of sun. Visibility good, slight haze.	Areas of high cloud, some sun breaking through, mainly near to coast afternoon. Visibility very good.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	10 to 12C, still quite humid.	9 or 10C.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits	Above the summits

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Tuesday, 1 July, 2025**

Cooler across Scotland by Monday night as a cold front advances eastwards. Risk of scattered thundery showers Tuesday-Wednesday, mostly eastern areas. High pressure then builds to the south, whilst a humid southwesterly returns to bring spells of rain and low cloud to western Scotland. The second week of July looks cooler for all with sunshine and showers.
