

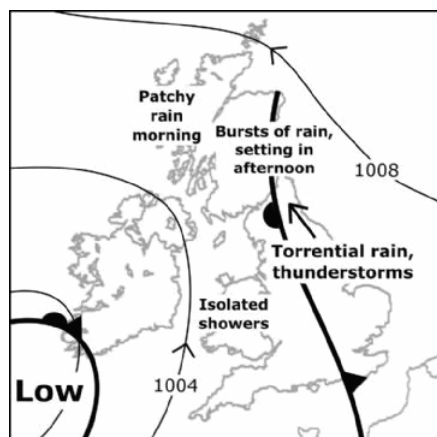
# Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

## General Summary for Saturday, 19 July, 2025



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 19 July, 2025

Some early rain near west coast, but the Highlands largely dry in morning. Into afternoon, bursts of rain becoming extensive heavy rain. A swathe of prolonged heavy rain moves north over England; intense downpours and thunderstorms, focused on Pennines. A few local showers Wales, but often dry. Fairly warm, locally gusty.

### Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Varied cloud, possible showers. Mostly light wind.

## Detailed Forecast for Saturday, 19 July, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	South to southeasterly, mostly 10mph or less, but toward west coast risk gusty 20mph for periods, more widely afternoon.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Mostly small</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Risk of a shower</b> Often dry much of the day, bar an odd patch of rain or brief heavy shower, chance of very isolated thunder afternoon-evening.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Lifting, clearing many tops</b> Patchy cloud banks on hills in the morning. Lifting into middle of day to upper slopes and breaking above tops. Some patches may come and go over upper slopes, patches lower around showers.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>40% rising to 70%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	High cloud often covering the sky, but some sun breaking through afternoon. Visibility increasingly very good.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	13 or 14C, small variation.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits
