



General Summary for Saturday, 23 August, 2025



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 23 August, 2025

Cloudy skies for many places, varied areas of low cloud on some hill slopes in the morning, largely lifting above the tops, but may continue to cap higher western mountains in Scotland, with a little rain occasionally. An odd shower in north Wales in afternoon. Winds generally light.

Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Largely dry, isolated showers, cloud lifting above hills; light winds.

Detailed Forecast for Saturday, 23 August, 2025

How windy? (On the summits)	Southeasterly or variable 5 to 10mph.
Effect of wind on you?	Negligible
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Little or no rain, locally a shower Chance an odd patch of drizzle around early low cloud. A few well scattered showers forming during afternoon, very locally a heavier one possible.
Cloud on the hills?	Risk covering some tops for a few hours Patchy low cloud at varied heights from dawn, may linger on some tops for a few hours. Most cloud likely lifting above the hills by middle of day.
Chance of cloud free summits?	70% rising to 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Occasional sun and mostly thin high cloud. May start misty, visibility becoming excellent.
How Cold? (at 900m)	10C from dawn. Rising to 14C afternoon.
Freezing Level	Above the summits

All mountain areas of Britain from Sunday, 24 August, 2025

High pressure drifts slowly east, whilst low pressure over the Atlantic encroaches nearer in the early part of the new week. Southeasterly winds increasing Sunday-Monday, soonest for western regions, becoming much windier by Monday in west, then more widely with time. Areas of rain and showery bursts increasingly widespread as the week progresses as low pressure then rotates slowly over Britain - day-to-day detail becomes very uncertain. Warmer and more humid for a time, then cooler later in week.

Forecasts are issued daily by 16:30 and are kept under review and amended as necessary. However, expected conditions can still change after issue. © Copyright Mountain Weather Information Service, 2025.
