

General Summary for Saturday, 23 August, 2025



British Mountain Summary: Based on forecast chart for noon 23 August, 2025

Cloudy skies for many places, varied areas of low cloud on some hill slopes in the morning, largely lifting above the tops, but may continue to cap higher western mountains in Scotland, with a little rain occasionally. An odd shower in north Wales in afternoon. Winds generally light.

Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Largely dry, isolated showers, cloud lifting above hills; light winds.

Detailed Forecast for Saturday, 23 August, 2025

How windy? (On the summits) Effect of wind on you?	Southerly 10 to 15mph, reaching 20-25mph in places mainly hills toward west coast and on Llyn peninsula. Fairly small, but feeling noticeably gusty on some western hills.	Southerly, strengthening, 25-35mph, reaching 40-45mph higher mountains around Yr Wyddfa/Snowdon. Increasingly affecting comfortable walking on exposed higher terrain, becoming more challenging in places, buffeting gusts.
How wet?	Rain unlikely	Rain unlikely until late
(Precipitation and its impact)	Small chance an isolated light shower.	Dry most or all day. Chance of odd spots from thickening high cloud. By evening into night, risk of steadier rain developing from southwest, may turn heavy.
Cloud on the hills?	Varied, but mostly clearing	Generally clear

Planning Outlook

All mountain areas of Britain from Sunday, 24 August, 2025

High pressure drifts slowly east, whilst low pressure over the Atlantic encroaches nearer in the early part of the new week. Southeasterly winds increasing Sunday-Monday, soonest for western regions, becoming much windier by Monday in west, then more widely with time. Areas of rain and showery bursts increasingly widespread as the week progresses as low pressure then rotates slowly over Britain - day-to-day detail becomes very uncertain. Warmer and more humid for a time, then cooler later in week.
