

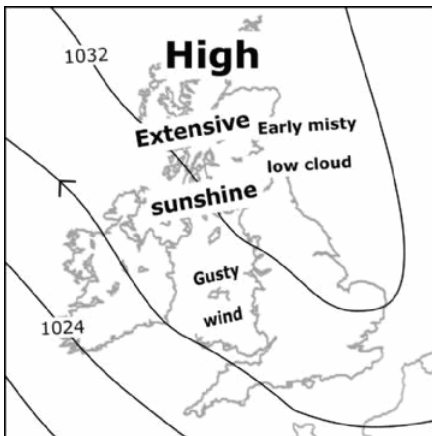
# Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

## General Summary for Thursday, 23 April, 2026



**British Mountain Summary:**  
**Based on forecast chart for noon 23 April, 2026**

Gusty easterly winds for England, Wales and southern Scotland, but warmer and less windy overall than recent days. Light winds for much of the Highlands. Some early low-level mist, mostly toward eastern Pennines, but the mountains clear with bright sunshine widely; high UV levels, beware sunburn.

**Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park**

Strong gusty and cool wind. Sunshine, warm valleys.

## Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 23 April, 2026

| <b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>                | East or southeasterly 25 to often 30mph around higher mountains, gusts 35-40mph near and west of high tops and through passes, locally downslope especially mid-Wales, lessening a little toward evening. |
| <b>Effect of wind on you?</b>                     | <b>Blustery over the hills, making walking strenuous in exposure, buffeting gusts will affect balance not just on highest terrain. Marked wind chill despite mild air.</b>                                |
| <b>How wet?</b><br>(Precipitation and its impact) | <b>No precipitation expected</b>  |
| <b>Cloud on the hills?</b>                        | <b>Little or none</b><br>Possible patchy cloud some eastern slopes early morning, otherwise the mountains clear.  |
| <b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>              | <b>Above 90%</b>  |
| <b>Sunshine?</b><br>Air clarity (below cloud)     | Extensive sunshine.<br>Visibility good, some slight haze.   |
| <b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>                        | 7 or 8C, small variation all day.<br>Feeling like 0 to -3C if directly in the wind.   |
| <b>Freezing Level</b>                             | Frost in sheltered valleys at dawn.<br>Otherwise above freezing to the summits.   |

| <b>Sunshine?</b><br>Air clarity (below cloud)                          | Extensive sunshine.<br>Very good visibility, slight low-level haze.  | Extensive sunshine, thin high cloud may thicken to cover the sky.<br>Visibility good, slight low-level haze.                    |
| <b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b><br><br><b>Freezing Level</b>                | 11 or 12C, little change on high terrain (Valleys start much cooler, then approach 20C especially in west afternoon).<br><br>Above the summits.<br>At dawn, slight frost inland valleys and possibly sheltered elevated hollows. | Around 10C, little change all day.<br><br>Above the summits.<br>Patchy frost at dawn inland valleys and sheltered higher areas. |

## Planning Outlook

### All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 24 April, 2026

A generally dry spell of weather continues into the weekend and next week, with mostly light winds and pleasantly warm temperatures, reaching 10C+ on many tops. Valleys and some sheltered higher areas will see some frosty dawns but by the afternoons many valleys will warm up toward 20C. Briefly cooler air drifts back into northeastern areas later Saturday. Strong April sunshine widely across the mountains, beware risk of sunburn. Misty starts in some valleys.
