

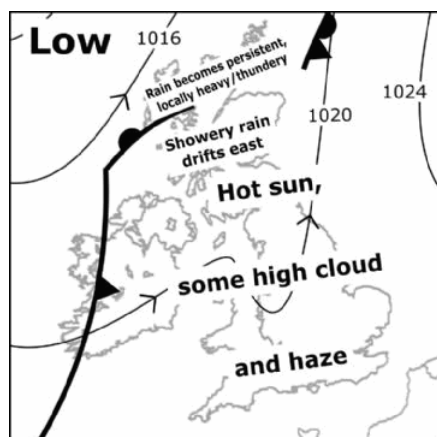

General Summary for Thursday, 13 August, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 13 August, 2026

Exceptionally hot in England and Wales, fire risk remains high. Despite haze and high cloud, beware sunburn and dehydration. Warm too in Scotland. Hill cloud and showery rain affects west Scotland from morning, patches spreading east; rain becomes frequent west Scotland later with heavy bursts.

Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Hot sun but hazy/smokey views

Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 13 August, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Southerly 20-30mph in the early morning, strong gusts over high terrain. Soon beginning to ease, trending westerly with some variability, settling near 10-15mph.
Effect of wind on you?	Blustery in exposure for a few early hours, gusts affecting ease of walking, soon easing to small effects.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain expected
Cloud on the hills?	Hills likely cloud-free during daylight A layer of cloud rests over Cardigan Bay which may begin to push onto low western slopes as night begins to fall.
Chance of cloud free summits?	Above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Mostly sunny, some high cloud around, most likely east. Hazy, smokey views due to fire in south Wales.
How Cold? (at 900m)	20 to 22C much of the day, valley temperatures approaching an unusually hot 30C in east Wales. A slight cooling trend beginning later afternoon.
Freezing Level	Above the summits.

All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 14 August, 2026

Mixed conditions early next week with periods of rain and sunny bursts. High pressure remains present to the southwest of the British Isles, maintaining the possibility of drier brighter days; detail remains uncertain regarding risk of more unsettled weather. Temperatures likely nearer average.
