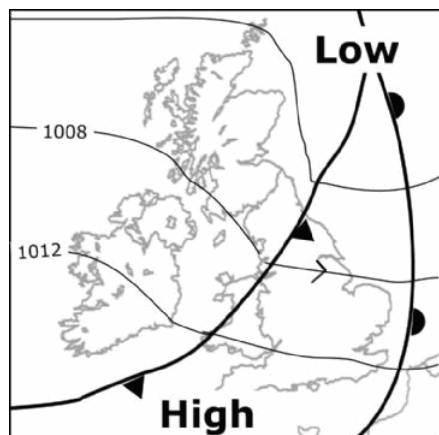

### General Summary for Sunday, 3 August, 2025



#### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 3 August, 2025

Rain, low cloud and fog ahead of a front will clear Scotland late morning and England and Wales afternoon - but high humidity may maintain a little drizzle and low cloud Wales (most likely SW). Cloud base may not rise sufficiently to clear higher mountains mainly in W Scotland.

#### Headline for Southeastern Highlands

Improving: wind easing; rain clearing to the odd shower, low cloud clearing.

### Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 3 August, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the Munros)</b>	Westerly, soon 20-25mph. strongest near central belt, but up to 35mph post dawn. By mid afternoon, 15 to 20mph across region.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Soon fairly small.
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain on and off clearing to the odd shower by later morning.</b> From dawn, frequent rain and drizzle until mid or late morning (easing from west). Then extensively dry, but perhaps a few showers afternoon.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Fog across the mountains; improving markedly - clearing afternoon.</b> From dawn, extensive across the mountains. By mid or late morning, cloud base 600-900m, a little higher near and east of Glenshee. Into afternoon, little cloud at all on the summits.
<b>Chance of cloud free Munros?</b>	<b>Less than 10%, rising to 90% by mid afternoon</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Patchwork of sunshine coming through from west middle of day onwards, sunniest east of A9. Good visibility although slight haze.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	Between 10 and 13C generally warmest easternmost summits.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits
