

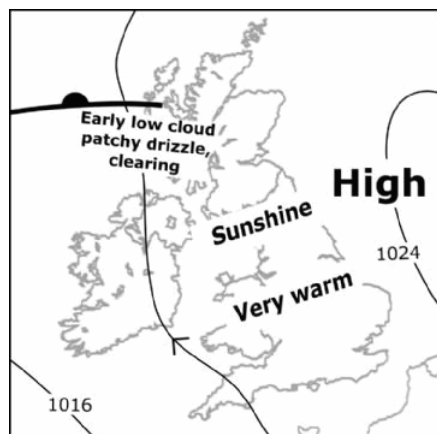
# West Highlands

Western Highlands accessible from, and south of, Glenfinnan (Road to the Isles) and Glen Spean (includes Creag Meagaidh). This area includes Ben Nevis and the mountains around Glencoe. In the east, from Ben Alder south to Loch Lomond and Trossachs NP. Also Arran and Mull.

## General Summary for Thursday, 19 June, 2025



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 19 June, 2025

Low cloud over western Scotland covering hills in the morning particularly near coast, breaking up from the south to become increasingly sunny across the Highlands. Light southerly winds. Very warm with strong sunshine for England and Wales, warmer air extending into Scotland during the day.

### Headline for West Highlands

Cloud patches gradually breaking. Warming up.

## Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 19 June, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the Munros)</b>	South to southwesterly 10 to 15mph, locally 20mph around Mull, increasing a little later in day.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Mostly small
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>No rain expected</b> Misty drizzle possible on some coastal slopes if in cloud in the morning.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Covering hills in morning, for longest Mull</b> Cloud banks most extensive around coastal slopes and islands, for a time more widely inland in the early morning, gradually clearing, but may last for several hours near Mull, tending to disperse into afternoon here.
<b>Chance of cloud free Munros?</b>	<b>50% rising to 80%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Varied high cloud, some lower cloud in morning, misty some coasts; sun breaking through from south increasingly. Visibility becoming generally very good.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	8 to 10C from dawn and where in cloud, rising to 12 to 14C, then little change into evening and night.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits
