

# Yorkshire Dales & North Pennines

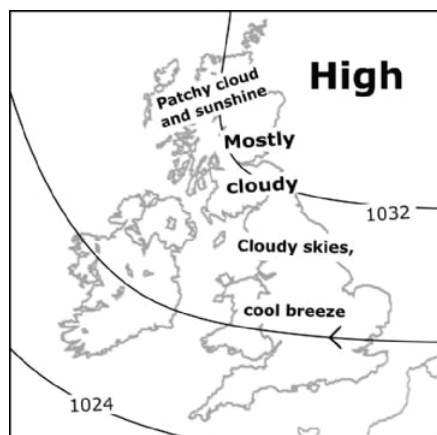

## General Summary for Monday, 17 March, 2025



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 17 March, 2025

Staying near freezing on higher tops. Light winds for the Highlands, a chilly easterly breeze further south. Generally dry but rather cloudy, although much cloud lifting above the hills. Best sunshine toward the north and northwest of Scotland, also nearer western coasts in England and Wales.

Chilly breeze. Dry but mostly cloudy.

## Detailed Forecast for Monday, 17 March, 2025

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Easterly 15-25mph. Some local gusts near and just west of high summits.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Fairly small, walking starting to be impeded in highest winds, some gusts may be quite inconvenient. Notable wind chill.
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	No precipitation expected
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Few banks in the east, mostly clear</b> Occasional patches onto upper eastern slopes and high tops in the morning. Bases will rise and likely clear all areas by afternoon.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	80%
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Fairly cloudy, glimpses of sun mostly west. Visibility excellent.
<b>How Cold? (at 700m)</b>	-1C rising to +1C. Feeling like -8C in the wind.
<b>And in the valleys</b>	Frost in many valleys and sheltered areas at dawn. Rising to 5 to 7C afternoon.
